

Remark:

1) For the purpose of valuation, we have considered the land area as per Approved Plan & Sale Deed and Built Up area as per Occupancy Certificate & Approved Plan.

<u>Justification for price / rate</u>

The Market Value of the property is based on facts of markets discovered by us during our enquiries, however the government rate value in this case is less than the market value arrived by us. We are of the opinion that the value arrive by us will prove to be correct if an Auction of the subject property is carried out. As far as Market Value in Index II is concerned, it is not possible to comment on same, may be government rates are fixed by sampling during same point of time in part and whereas, Market values change every month.

In most of the cases the actual deal amount or Transaction value is not reflected in Index II because of various Market practices. As Valuer, we always try to give a value which is correct reflection of actual transaction value irrespective of any factors in market.

Method of Valuation / Approach

The cost approach is a Real Property Valuation method which considers the value of a property as the cost of the land plus the replacement cost of the building (construction costs) minus the physical and functional depreciation. This approach is most commonly used for real estate properties that are not easily sold like schools, hospitals, government buildings and above type of property.

Land cost can be estimated using the Sales Comparison Approach by studying recent sales of land close to the subject property, and these sales should be comparable in size and location with subject property.

There are different ways to estimate replacement costs, the most common being finding out the cost to build a square foot of comparable properties multiplied by the total square footage of the building. The cost approach is commonly used for Residential Bungalow, Residential Building and properties mentioned above.

As the property is an Residential land and building thereof, we have adopted Cost approach / Land and Building Method for the purpose of valuation. The Price for similar type of property in the nearby vicinity is in the range of ₹ 19,000.00 to ₹ 27,000.00 per Sq. M. for land and Structure thereof Considering the rate with attached report, current market conditions, demand and supply position, Land size, location, sustained demand for Residential building / Plot, all round development of commercial and Residential application in the locality etc.

We estimate ₹ 20,000.00 per Sq. M. for Land with appropriate cost of construction for valuation.








ROUTE MAP OF THE PROPERTY

Note: The Blue line shows the route to site from nearest Railway Station (Nashik – 14.4 Km)






