Justification for price / rate

The Market Value of the property is based on facts of markets discovered by us during our enquiries, however the government rate value in this case is less than the market value arrived by us. We are of the opinion that the value arrive by us will prove to be correct if an Auction of the subject property is carried out. As far as Market Value in Index II is concerned, it is not possible to comment on same, may be government rates are fixed by sampling during same point of time in part and whereas, Market values change every month.

In most of the cases the actual deal amount or Transaction value is not reflected in Index II because of various Market practices. As Valuer, we always try to give a value which is correct reflection of actual transaction value irrespective of any factors in market.

Method of Valuation / Approach


The sales comparison approach uses the market data of sale prices to estimate the value of a real estate property. Property valuation in this method is done by comparing a property to other similar properties that have been recently sold. Comparable properties, also known as comparables, or comps, must share certain features with the property in question. Some of these include physical features such as square footage, number of rooms, condition, and age of the building; however, the most important factor is no doubt the location of the property. Adjustments are usually needed to account for differences as no two properties are exactly the same. To make proper adjustments when comparing properties, real estate appraisers must know the differences between the comparable properties and how to value these differences. The sales comparison approach is commonly used for Residential Flat, where there are typically many comparables available to analyze. As the property is a Residential Flat, we have adopted Sale Comparison Approach Method for the purpose of valuation. The Price for similar type of property in the nearby vicinity is in the range of ₹ 3,000.00 to ₹ 3,500.00 per Sq. Ft. on Built up Area. Considering the rate with attached report, current market conditions, demand and supply position, Flat size, location, upswing in real estate prices, sustained demand for Residential Flat, all-round development of commercial and residential application in the locality etc. We estimate ₹ 3,040.00 per Sq. Ft. on Built up Area for valuation after depreciation.








Route Map of the property

Valuation Methodology

For the purpose of this valuation exercise, the valuation methodology used is Direct Comparison Approach Method and proposed Current use / Existing use premise is considered for this assignment.

The Direct Comparison Approach involves a comparison of the property being valued to similar properties that have actually been sold in arms - length transactions or are offered for sale. This approach demonstrates what buyers have historically been willing to pay (and sellers willing to accept) for similar properties in an open and competitive market and is particularly useful in estimating the value of the Flat and properties that are typically traded on a unit basis.

In case of inadequate recent transaction activity in the subject micro-market, the appraiser would collate details of older transactions. Subsequently, the appraiser would analyse rental / capital value trends in the subject micro-market in order to calculate the percentage increase / decrease in values since the date of the identified transactions. Integrity and Fairness

- 1. A valuer shall, in the conduct of his/its business, follow high standards of integrity and fairness in all his/its dealings with his/its clients and other valuers.
- 2. A valuer shall maintain integrity by being honest, straightforward, and forthright in all professional relationships.
- 3. A valuer shall endeavour to ensure that he/it provides true and adequate information and shall not misrepresent any facts or situations.
- 4. A valuer shall refrain from being involved in any action that would bring disrepute to the profession.
- 5. A valuer shall keep public interest foremost while delivering his services.

Professional Competence and Due Care

- 6. A valuer shall render at all times high standards of service, exercise due diligence, ensure proper care and exercise independent professional judgment.
- 7. A valuer shall carry out professional services in accordance with the relevant technical and professional standards that may be specified from time to time.
- A valuer shall continuously maintain professional knowledge and skill to provide competent professional service based on up-to-date developments in practice, prevailing regulations / guidelines and techniques.
- 9. In the preparation of a valuation report, the valuer shall not disclaim liability for his/its expertise or deny his/its duty of care, except to the extent that the assumptions are based on statements of fact provided by the company or its auditors or consultants or information available in public domain and not generated by the valuer.
