The structural design, building materials, plumbing to the protection bleerical installation etc. shall be in accordance with the provision (except for provision hyrespect of floor area ratio) as prescribed in the National Building Code amanded from time to time by the Indian Standard Institutions.

- 4) The Certificate shall remain valid for a period of one year from the date of Issue and can be further revalidated as required under provision of Section M. R. & T. P. Act, 1966.
