- 2(b) Give written notice to the Corporation regarding completion of the work.
- 2(c) Obtain Occupancy Certificate from the Corporation.
- 2(d) Permit authorised officers of the Corporation to enter the building or premises, for which the permission has been granted, at any time for the purpose of ensuring the building control Regulations and conditions of this certificate.

The structural design, building materials, installations, electrical installations etc. Shall conform to the provisions (except for provision in respect of floor area ratio) as prescribed in the National Building Code or and / or GDCRs - 1975 in force.
