of MARCH One thousand nine hundred and sixty-one BETWEEN SHREE LUXMI WOOLLEN MILLS ESTATE PRIVATE LIMITED a Company incorporated under the Companies Act I of 1956 and having its registered office at Bombay hereinafter called "the Surrenderor" (which expression shall, unless the context does not so admit be deemed to include its successors and assigns) of the one part and THE GOVERNOR OF MAHARASHTRA hereinafter called "the Lessor" (which expression shall, unless the context does not so admit, include his successors and assigns) of the other part.

WHEREAS by a Lease dated the 31st day of December 1952 made between the Governor of Bombay of the one part and Shree Mahalaxmi Woollen Mills Limited a Company incorported under the Indian Companies Act, VII of 1913, of the other part and registered with the Sub-Registrar of Bombay on the 9th November 1953 under Serial No. 912 at pages 189-92 of Volume 306 of Additional Book No. 1, ALL that piece of land situate near Haines Road within the City and Registration (G.C.P.) 1-18 II 3521—1

which two parts are respectively described in the Second and Third Schedules hereto and for granting a separate lease in respect of the plot admeasuring 5,477 square yards described in the said Second Schedule.

AND WHEREAS by his letter dated the 13th July 1960 bearing No. SB/CC2/LND-1306 the Collector of Bombay communicated to the Surrenderor the Government sanction to the proposed sub-division subject to the Surrenderor agreeing inter alia to surrender the said land and premises more particularly described in the said Second Schedule hereto and to pay to the Lessor a sum of Rs. 3,000/- as premium for the grant of the fresh lease.

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the provisions of the Bombay Reorganisation Act, 1960, the executive power formerly exercisable by the Governor of Bombay with respect to the said lease became and is now exercisable by the Lessor.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS :-

1. In consideration of the premises the Surrenderor doth hereby convey and surrender unto the Lessor ALL that piece or parcel of land situate near Haines Road within the City and Registration Sub-District of Bombay containing by admeasurement 5,477 square yards or thereabouts and more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto AND all the estate right title and interest of the Surrenderor therein to the intent that the residue now to come and unexpired of the said term granted by the hereinbefore recited Indenture of Lease may be merged in the reversion expectant upon the termination of the aforesaid lease and that the said lease in respect of the land and premises more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto may be extinguished and the Surrenderor doth hereby covenant with the Lessor that notwithstanding any act, deed or thing by the


