


The applicant shall :

- 2(a) Give a notice to the Corporation for completion of development work upto plinth level, atleast 7 days before the commencement of the further work.
- 2(b) Give written notice to the Corporation regarding completion of the work.
- 2(c) Obtain Occupancy Certificate from the Corporation.
- 2(d) Permit authorised officers of the Corporation to enter the building or premises, for which the permission has been granted, at any time for the purpose of ensuring the building control Regulations and conditions of this certificate.

3. The all general design, building materials, installations, electrical installations etc. Shall be in accordance with the provision (except for provision in respect of floor area ratio) as prescribed in the National Building Code or and / or GDCRs - 1975 in force.

4. The Certificate shall remain valid for period of 1 year from the date of its issue, thereafter re-validation of the same shall be done in accordance with provision of Section-46 of MRTP Act- 1966 and as per regulation no. 16.1(2) of the GDCRs - 1975.
