2. The applicant shall:

2(a) Give a notice to the Corporation for completion of development work unto plinth level, atleast 7 days before the commencement of the further work.

2(b) Give written notice to the Corporation regarding completion of the work.

2(c) Obtain Occupancy Certificate from the Corporation.

2(d) Permit authorised officers of the Corporation to enter the building or premises, for which the permission has been granted, at any time for the purpose of ensuring the building control Regulations and conditions of this certificate.

The structural design, building materials, installations, electrical installations etc. Shall be in accordance with the provision (except for provision in respect of floor area ratio) as prescribed in the National Building Code or and / or GDCRr - 1975 in force.

The Certificate shall remain valid for period of 1 year from the date of its issue, thereafter revalidation of the same shall be done in accordance with provision of Section-48 of MRTP Act- 1966 and as per regulation no.16.1(2) of the GDCRs - 1975.

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The conditions of this certificate shall be binding not only on the applicant but also on its successors and for every person deriving title through or under him.

certified copy of the approved plan shall be exhibited on site.

The amount of Rs. 7500 deposited with CIDCO as security deposit shall be forfeited either in whole or in part at the absolute discretion of the Corporation for breach of any of the conditions attached to the permission covered by the Commencement Certificate. Such forfeiture shall be without prejudice to any other remedy or right of Corporation.

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As per the notification dtd. 14th September 1999 and amendment on 27th August 2003, issued by Ministry of Environment & Forest (MOEF), Govt. of India and as per Circular issued by Urban Development Deptt., Govt. of Maharashtra, vide No. FAR/102004/160/P.No.27/UD-20, dtd. 27/02/2004, for all Buildings following additional condition shall apply:

The Owners Developer shall use Fly Ash bricks or blocks or tiles or day fly bricks or cement fly ash bricks or blocks or similar products of a combination of aggregate of them to the extent of 100% (by volume) of the total briefs, blocks & tiles as the case may be in their construction activity.
