Justification for Price / Rate

The Market Value of the property is based on facts of markets discovered by us during our enquiries, however the government rate value in this case is less than the market value arrived by us. We are of the opinion that the value arrive by us will prove to be correct if an Auction of the subject property is carried out. As far as Market Value in Index II is concerned, it is not possible to comment on same, may be government rates are fixed by sampling during same point of time in part and whereas, Market values change every month.

In most of the cases the actual deal amount or Transaction value is not reflected in Index II because of various Market practices. As Valuer, we always try to give a value which is correct reflection of actual transaction value irrespective of any factors in market.

Method of Valuation / Approach

The sales comparison approach uses the market data of sale prices to estimate the value of a real estate property. Property valuation in this method is done by comparing a property to other similar properties that have been recently sold. Comparable properties, also known as comparables, or comps, must share certain features with the property in question. Some of these include physical features such as square footage, number of rooms, condition, and age of the building; however, the most important factor is no doubt the location of the property. Adjustments are usually needed to account for differences as no two properties are exactly the same. To make proper adjustments when comparing properties, real estate appraisers must know the differences between the comparable properties and how to value these differences. The sales comparison approach is commonly used for Residential Flat, where there are typically many comparables available to analyze. As the property is a Residential Flat, we have adopted Sale Comparison Approach Method for the purpose of valuation .The Price for similar type of property in the nearby vicinity is in the range of ₹ 5824.00 to ₹ 6200.00 per Sq. Ft. on Carpet Area / ₹ 4854.00 to ₹ 5167.00 per Sq. Ft. on BuiltUp Area. Considering the rate with attached report, current market conditions, demand and supply position, Flat size, location, upswing in real estate prices, sustained demand for Residential Flat, all round development of Residential and Commercial application in the locality etc. We estimate ₹6,100.00 per Sq. Ft. on Carpet Area for valuation.








Route Map of the property





MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR VALUERS

(Adopted in line with Companies (Registered Valuers and Valuation Rules, 2017))

All valuers empanelled with bank shall strictly adhere to the following code of conduct:

Integrity and Fairness

- 1. A valuer shall, in the conduct of his/its business, follow high standards of integrity and fairness in all his/its dealings with his/its clients and other valuers.
- 2. A valuer shall maintain integrity by being honest, straightforward, and forthright in all professional relationships.
- 3. A valuer shall endeavour to ensure that he/it provides true and adequate information and shall not misrepresent any facts or situations.
- 4. A valuer shall refrain from being involved in any action that would bring disrepute to the profession.
- 5. A valuer shall keep public interest foremost while delivering his services.

Professional Competence and Due Care

- 6. A valuer shall render at all times high standards of service, exercise due diligence, ensure proper care and exercise independent professional judgment.
- 7. A valuer shall carry out professional services in accordance with the relevant technical and professional standards that may be specified from time to time.
- 8. A valuer shall continuously maintain professional knowledge and skill to provide competent professional service based on up-to-date developments in practice, prevailing regulations / guidelines and techniques.
